She was a founding member of the Hispanic Leadership Council and Sears Neighborhood Revitalization Committee.

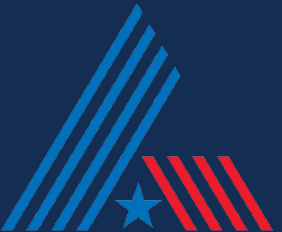
She served on several AISD and City of Abilene committees, including, the Planning and Zoning Committee and Abilene ISD Bond Committee and many other organizations, too many to mention.

Ovelia, or Ovie, as she was known to all her family and friends, was a die-hard Abilene High Eagle and loved and worked hard for her Abilene community.

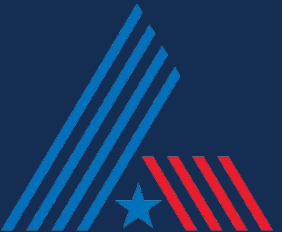

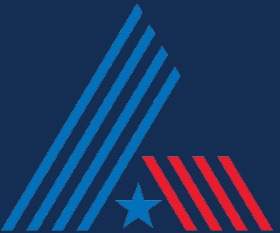
North and Middle Nelson Lakes Currently



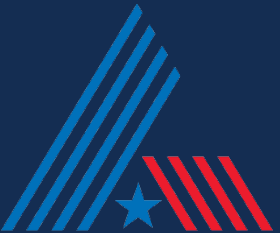
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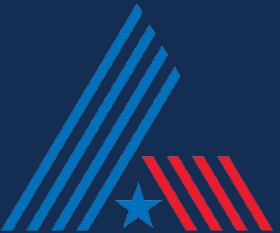
North Grassland Rendering

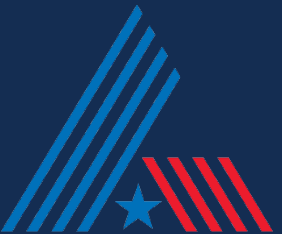
