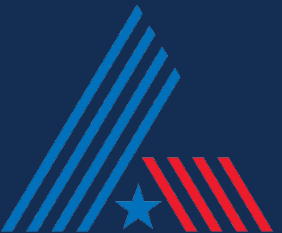




Giraffe Calf born on August 13, 2022



Angolan Colobus born August 15, 2022

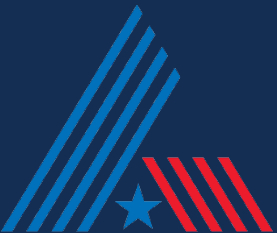


American Institution of Rhinoceros Study (AIRS)
