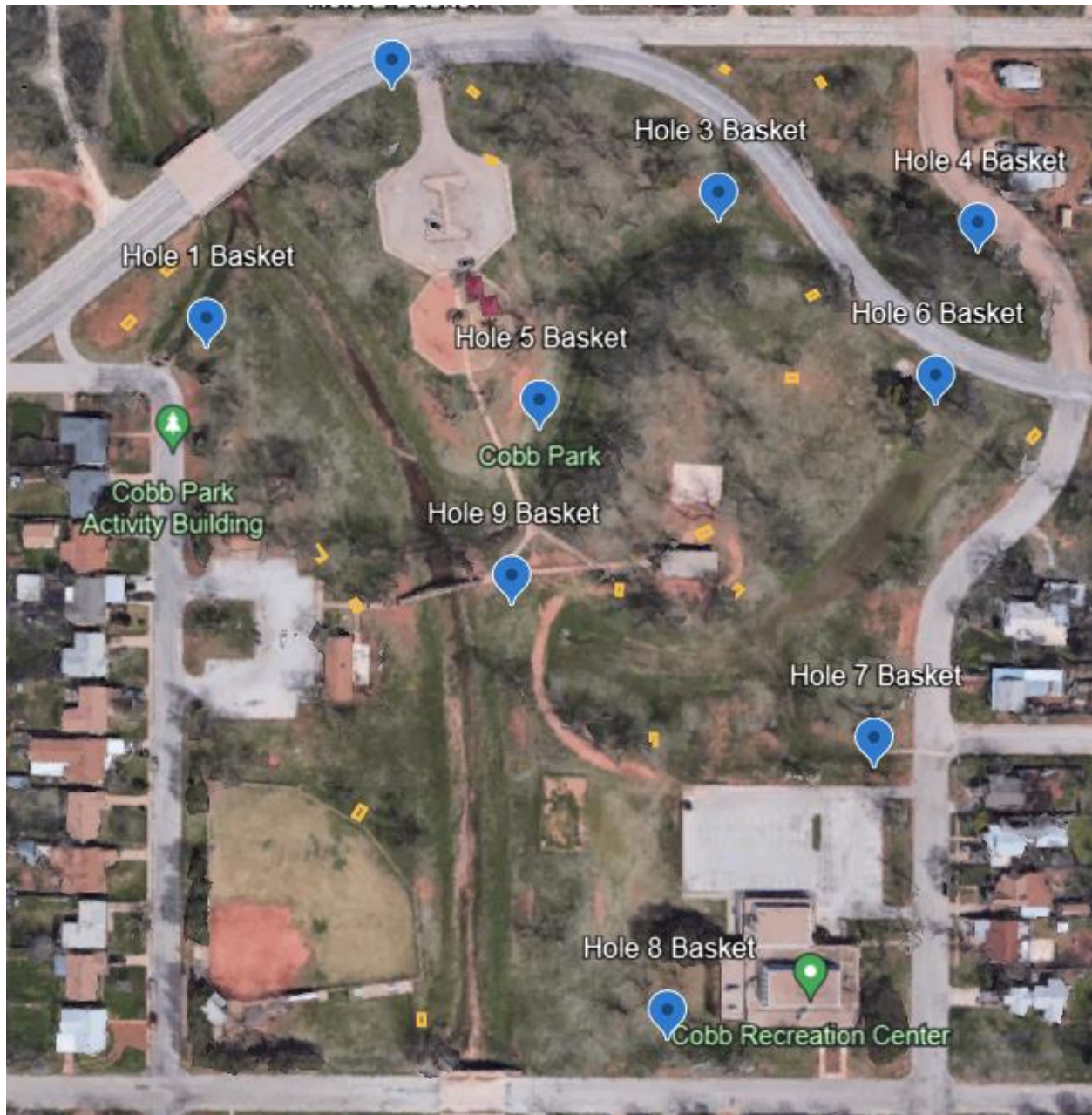

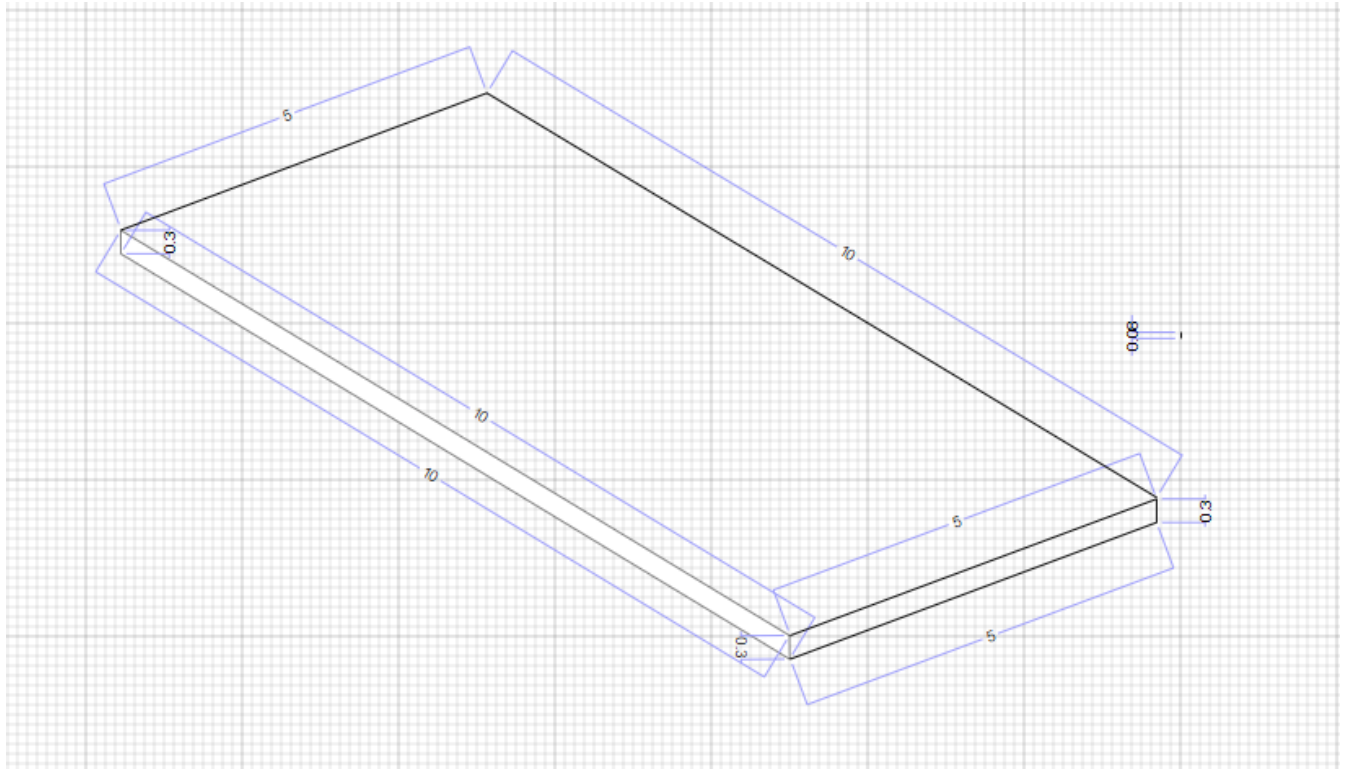

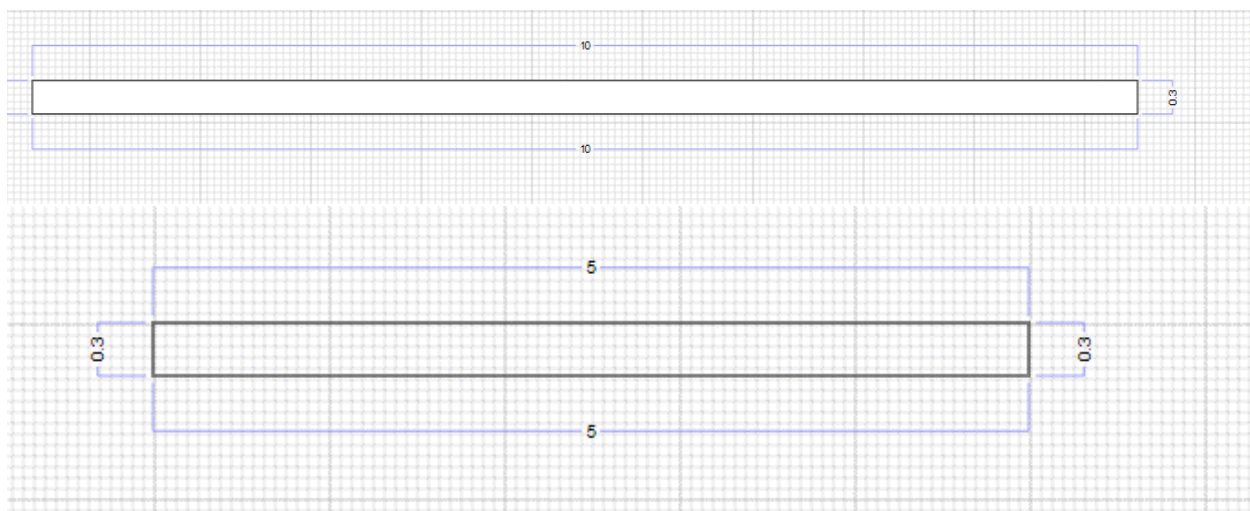


Cobb Park Tee Pad Project

Materials:

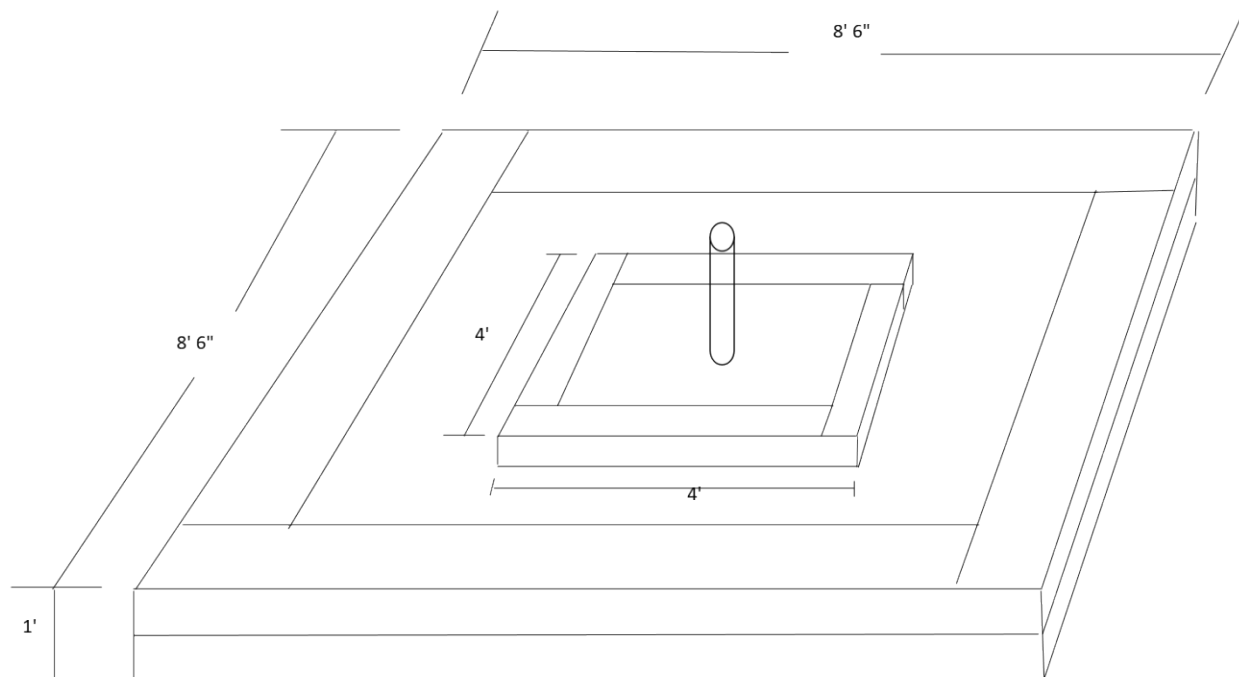
12 - Pressure Treated ground timber 6" x 6" X 8'
40 - 12 " galvanized landscape spikes
10 - 24" rebar stakes
4 ton - Crushed Granite

Costs:

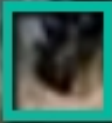
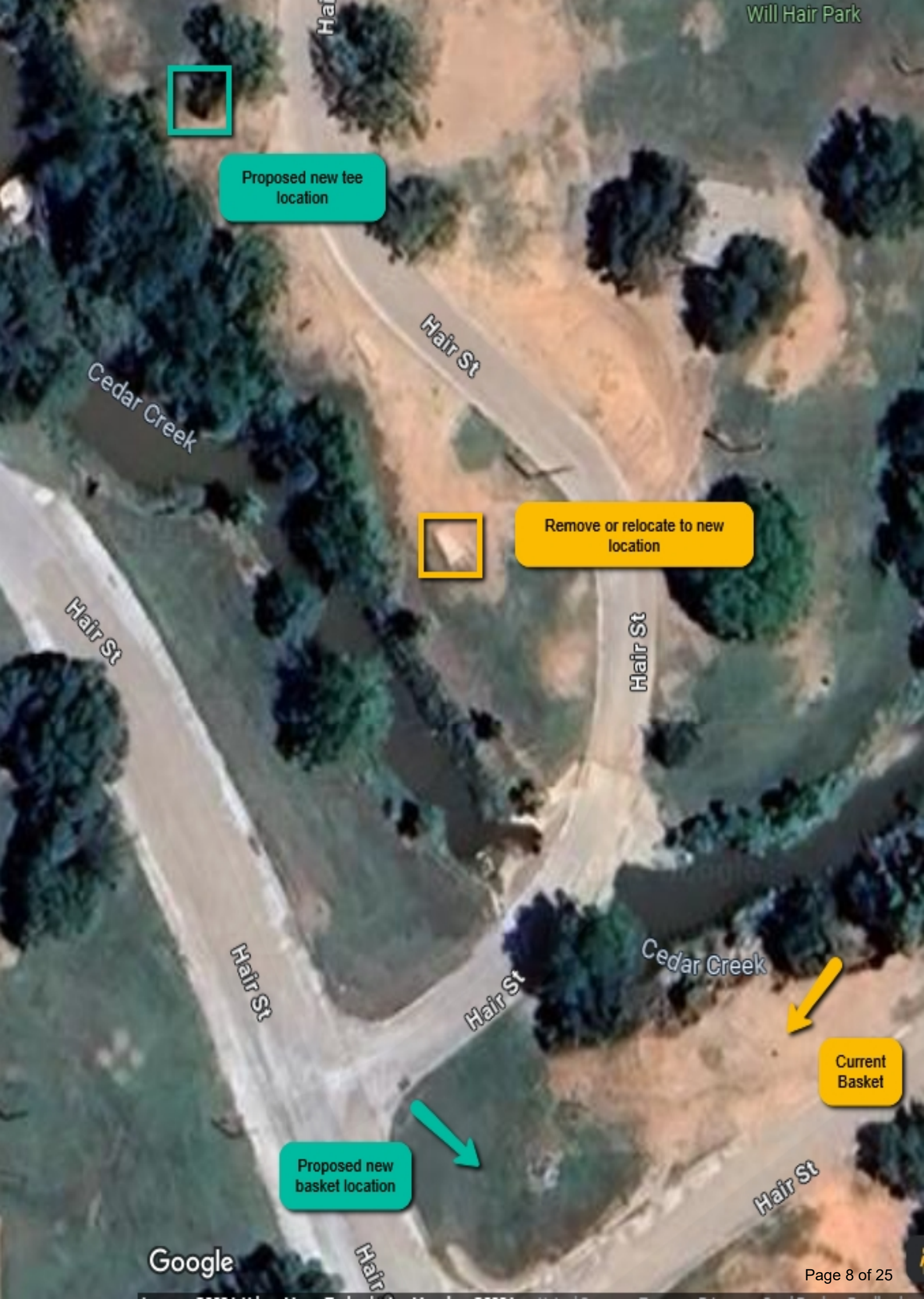
Materials - \$1,167.20
Labor - Donated by ADGA volunteers

Structure Plan:

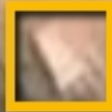
1. 8 ft timbers will be laid at ground level and secured using landscape spikes. Timbers will be stacked.
2. First layer will be filled with crushed granite and tamped into place.
3. 3.5 ft timbers will be laid inside and secured with landscape spikes. Timbers will be stacked.
4. Second layer will be filled with crushed granite and tamped into place

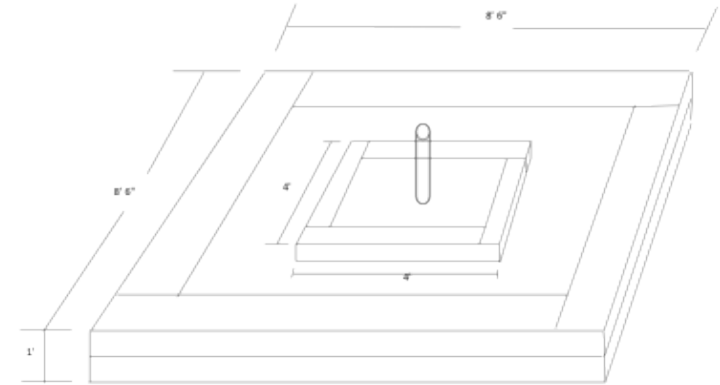
