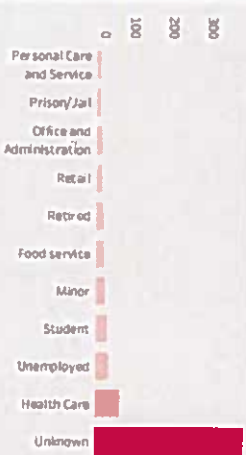

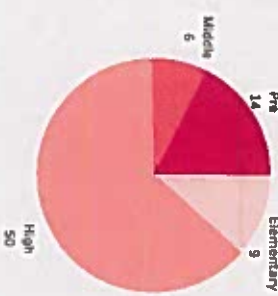

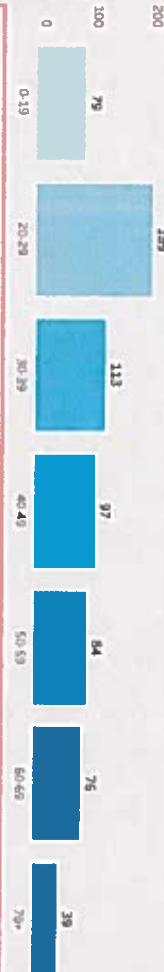
Positive by ANTIGEN per week

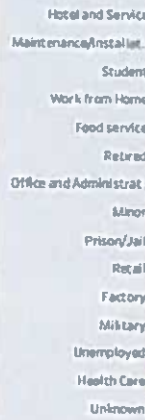
